

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

In a continuing effort to serve the needs of students in Career and Technical Education Programs, **Hillsborough Community College** enters into this agreement with **The School Board of Hillsborough County, Florida**, to award college credit toward an Associate in Science degree in Aquaculture to graduates of the Hillsborough County Public School's Career and Technical Education program in Aquaculture as delineated below:

This agreement makes it possible to award 6 articulated credits to a student who has completed the stated Hillsborough County Public School's Career and Technical Education Program of Study if the student meets the following criteria:

- Enroll in the Aquaculture Technology program seeking a degree in same;
- Request articulation within three years of high school graduation date;
- Furnish official copy of high school transcript indicating Aquaculture program completion;
- Satisfactorily complete the program with a B or better in the program courses;
- Must matriculate 15 credits of coursework at Hillsborough Community College on either a full or part-time basis to have these articulated credits noted on student's official college transcript.

AND

Hillsborough County Public Schools has complied with the following provisions:

- Hillsborough County Public Schools agrees to provide to the Aquaculture Department Chair copies of the course scope & sequences and FLDOE curriculum frameworks for each of the articulated courses prior to each academic school year:
 - 8106810, Agriscience Foundations 1
 - 8112010, Aquaculture 2
 - 8112020, Aquaculture 3
 - 8112030, Aquaculture 4
- Hillsborough County Public Schools agrees to meet the teaching objectives for each of the credited courses that Hillsborough Community College offers:
 - FAS1012C, Aquacultural Organisms
 - FAS1401L, Aquacultural Lab Techniques

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- Hillsborough County Public Schools agrees to use the following textbooks/online resources for the articulated courses and not to change textbooks/resources without the prior permission of the Aquaculture Department Chair:
 - Agriscience Fundamentals and Applications, 6th Edition, By Burton from Cengage Learning (9781133686880)
 - Aquaculture Science, 3rd Edition, By Parker from Delmar Cengage Learning (9781435488120)

The articulating agency will annually review the contents of the curriculum and qualifications of teachers employed by Hillsborough County Public Schools. The purpose of the review is to verify that competencies are being taught and are equivalent to the postsecondary institution's course(s) which has been designated as equivalent and for which college credit is being offered.


This articulation agreement for the 6 credit(s) toward the Hillsborough Community College Degree is effective upon both institutions' signatures, and will be reviewed five years from the latter date. This agreement may be terminated by either party upon 60 days written notice.


