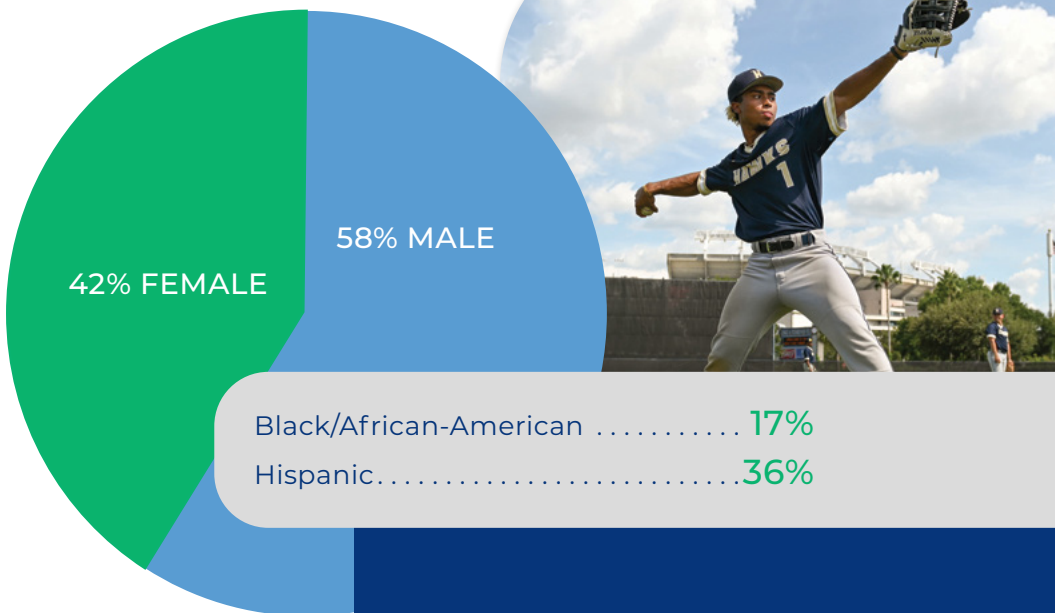
# OUR STUDENTS
