For this exhibit, David Audet presents a series of photo essays. They represent time spent in Europe in the 1970s to recent travels to Cuba and the American Southwest. “Soon after I started taking pictures in 1972, I knew this was to be my life-long diary of a melancholy love,” states Audet. “As life swirled around me I was astonished at how powerful, and fleeting, was the suddenly peculiar shadow on a wall or the oddness of a fearful smile. I was astonished that there was a machine to collect these moments in some semi-permanent fashion, and that they could be handmade... In this exhibit I give some of the pages of that diary, and in the viewers gaze I hope they provide proof of that astonishment.”

Audet is currently Projects Manager at HCC's Ybor Campus and is director of the HCC Ybor Festival of the Moving Image. David received his BFA in Film/Photography from the University of South Florida.

Judith Robertson studied sculpture and painting at the Rhode Island School of Design. “My work examines the consumerist's psyche. Signs of our obsession with material acquisitions abound in big box stores, the hyper-rise of easy credit, and the commoditization of branding. What is left behind forms an unfathomable stockpile of jettisoned objects. My work in this exhibit reclaims and juxtaposes mass-produced and discarded materials.”

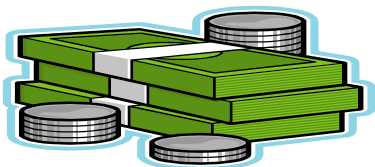
