The purpose of this form is to document the validation of acceptable forms of evidence of the students' competencies and acquired skills that meet program outcomes.

**Validation Mechanism:** To be eligible for articulated credit, the student must show evidence of their completed Associate Science, Nursing Degree from a regionally accredited educational institution **and** current RN Licensure. The student must have their official transcript submitted directly to HCC and provide objective documentation of their current Registered Nurse License.

For nursing graduates to be eligible to take the NCLEX-RN exam, the U.S. Nursing regulatory model dictates that the new nurse must show evidence of graduating from a nursing regulatory body approved nursing program. Nursing regulatory bodies rely heavily on each other to make sound program approval decisions so that mobility across jurisdictions can be seamless as possible (NCSBN.org). Therefore, nursing programs meeting national accreditation standards are noted to meet the same core requirements for their students to be eligible for the NCLEX-RN exam. For this reason, it is appropriate to grant articulated nursing credit to a student transferring the ASRN into the HCC BSN Completion program from another accredited nursing program.

The ASN and RN License will serve as equivalent substitutions for the HCC courses identified below.
