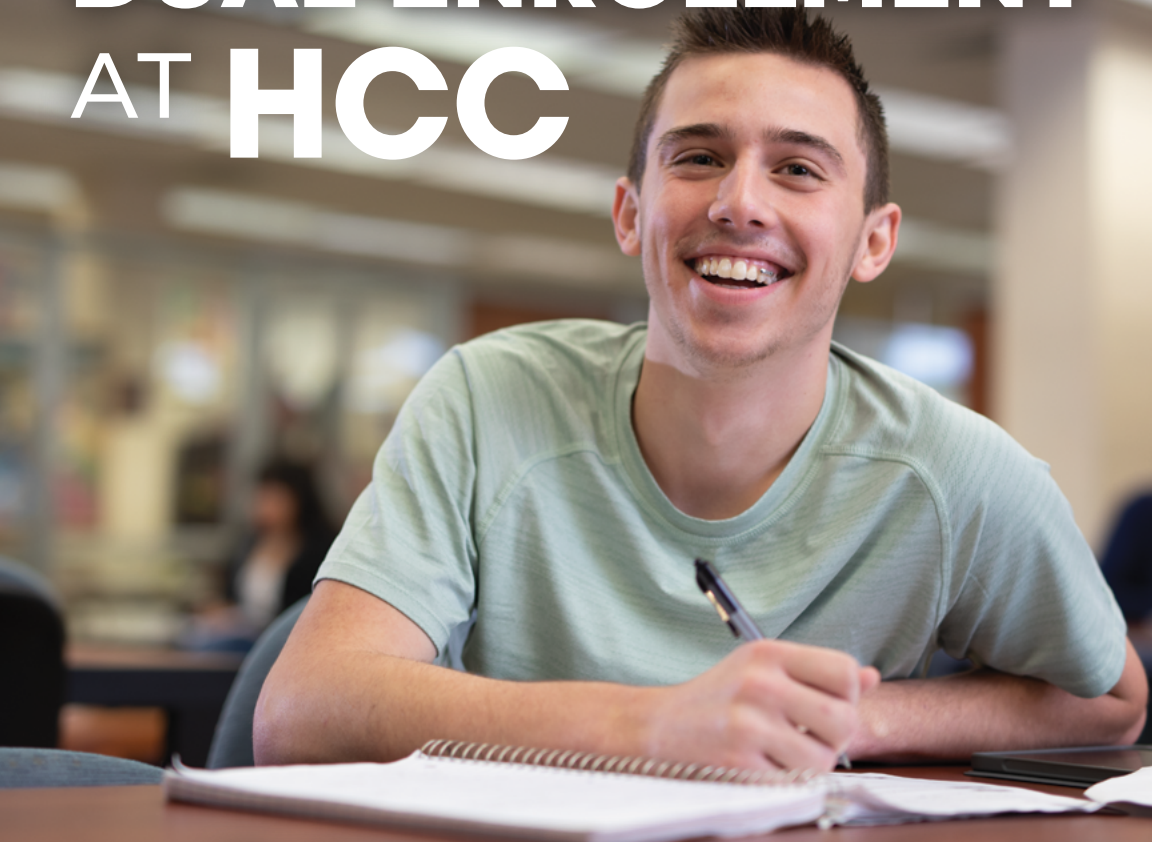

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## WHAT IS **DUAL ENROLLMENT?**

Dual enrollment allows high school students to earn college credit while working toward a high school diploma. Students who successfully complete dual enrollment courses will save time and money toward their college degrees.

## AM I **ELIGIBLE?**

To be eligible, a student must:

- Be enrolled in a Florida public or non-public secondary school or in a home education program.
- Have a 3.0 unweighted grade point average.
- Pass the appropriate sections of a college placement test with scores not more than two years old.
- Have permission from the parent/guardian and high school representative.

### HOW MUCH DOES DUAL ENROLLMENT COST?

Public, private and home education high school students are exempt from tuition and laboratory fees.

Textbooks are free for all dual enrollment students. Public high school students must return books because they are the property of the School District.

## WHEN AND WHERE DO I TAKE MY COURSES?

Students may take up to 10 credits per semester. The courses may be taken before, during or after school, and during the summer. They may be offered online, at the high school or on the College campus.

## WHAT IS **EARLY ADMISSION**?

Early Admission is a form of dual enrollment whereby eligible high school students are admitted to HCC as full-time students for the fall and spring semesters of their high school senior year. During the early admission year, students take 12-15 credits each semester. The courses they take earn credit toward both an associate in arts degree and completion of the high school diploma.

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## AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible, a student must:



Have an unweighted 3.5 high school GPA at the end of 11th grade.



Score at college level on SAT, ACT and/or PERT.



Not be in the running for a distinction (Valedictorian or Salutatorian).



Have completed all requirements for high school graduation or have one or more of the following courses remaining:

- 1 credit of English and/or
- 1 credit of Math and/or
- 0.5 credit of Economics and/or
- 0.5 credit of American Government

# PATH TO **DUAL ENROLLMENT** AT HCC

## START HERE

Submit an online Dual Enrollment Application at **[hccfl.edu/dualenrollment](http://hccfl.edu/dualenrollment)**.

## GET THE SCORES

Pass the appropriate sections of a college placement test or submit adequate SAT/ACT scores (not more than two years old).

3

## SHOW US WHAT YOU'VE GOT

Provide Authorization Form B (Public), Letter of Authorization (Private), Home Education Approval Form (Home) and your Student Permanent Record Summary Worksheet, recent Report Card or Transcript showing a 3.0 unweighted GPA. In addition, a signed Student/Parent Agreement must be submitted during the student's first term.

## CHECK AND DOUBLE-CHECK

Each term students must submit their paperwork to the Dual Enrollment Portal found on the HCC/ Dual Enrollment website. All dual enrollment paperwork must be received by the deadline date.

## WELCOME TO HCC!

Once you're approved, you will receive an approval email with instructions on how to register through your MyHCC account. Students must register by the deadline posted on the HCC/Dual Enrollment website.
