RESIDENCE CLASIFICATION (please read carefully)

A Florida "resident for tuition purposes" is a person who has, or a dependent person whose parent or legal guardian has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least 12 consecutive months. Residence in Florida must be for the purpose of establishing a permanent home and not merely incident to enrollment at an institution of higher education. Other persons not meeting the twelve-month legal residence requirements may be classed as Florida residents for tuition purposes only if they fall within one of the limited special categories authorized by the Florida Legislature. All other persons are ineligible for classification as a Florida "resident for tuition purposes".

To qualify as a Florida resident for tuition purposes you must a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or a legal alien granted indefinite stay by the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services. Living in or attending school in Florida will not, in itself, establish legal residence. Students who depend on out-of-state parents for support are presumed to be legal residents of the same state as their parents. Documents supporting the establishment of legal residence must be dated, issued, or filed 12 months before the first day of classes for the term for which a Florida resident classification is sought. A copy of your most recent tax return or other documentation may be requested to establish dependence/independence.

- DEFINITIONS: (A) DEPENDENT:** A person for whom 50% or more of his/her support is provided by another as defined by the Internal Revenue Service and is under age 24.
- (B) INDEPENDENT:** A person who provides more than 50% of his/her own support and is 24 or older.
