

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

SAINT LEO UNIVERSITY AND HILLSBOROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

I. SCOPE AND PURPOSE

- A. Articulated Programs:* Saint Leo University (SLU) and Hillsborough Community College (HCC) hereby enter into the following articulation agreement governing the matriculation selected Associate of Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), and Associate of Applied Science (AAS) graduates of Hillsborough Community College to Saint Leo University baccalaureate degree programs of business administration (management and accounting specializations), elementary education, human services and social work.
- B. Purpose:* It is the intention of this articulation agreement to facilitate a seamless transition from the Associate of Arts degree programs at HCC to baccalaureate degree programs at SLU.
- C. Understanding of the parties:* For all HCC graduates admitted to SLU during the term of this agreement, Saint Leo University will:

II. GENERAL EDUCATION

- A.* Students transferring with Associate in Arts (A.A.) coursework from HCC will be considered to have met all general education requirements with the exception of foundation courses and one religion course unless an equivalent course is transferred.
- B.* Associate in Science (A.S.) coursework is transferable to SLU and applied to meet degree requirements (including General Education and Electives) as applicable and within the limits mentioned below.
- C.* Students are required to enroll in a minimum of 15 semester hours in the major with SLU and a minimum of 30 semester hours with SLU. Students are required to earn a minimum of 120 semester hours to graduate. In addition, a minimum of 39 hours of coursework must be completed at the 300-400 level for the bachelor degrees.
- D.* General Education and Elective courses may be taken with SLU or if available, at HCC, depending upon the graduation needs of individual students.
- E.* Satisfaction of all prerequisites must be met for degree completion. Prerequisites may be satisfied at HCC or SLU.
- F.* The following table includes the General Education Requirements for Saint Leo University and the general education courses at HCC that will equate to Saint Leo's

general education courses. No course will be credited to both a major requirement and a UE requirement with the exception of mathematics.


Article 3 – Acceptance by Parties
